Public Transportation Guide for Upper Darby

How to Get to Important Destinations

This brochure is intended to give you general information about using public transportation to get to important places within Delaware County and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

What is SEPTA?

Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (SEPTA) is a network of busses, trolleys, subway/elevated lines and trains. SEPTA connects the entire region of Philadelphia and its four surrounding suburban counties in Southeastern Pennsylvania.

How to Ride

SEPTA services are available when you see this:



SEPTA busses will stop at specific locations marked with a sign showing the route number.

Asking for Information

When boarding, you can ask the driver or conductor if you are on the correct vehicle. You can also ask the driver where to get off the vehicle. Be sure to have your destination written in English to show to the driver if you need assistance.

Fare Information

Fare information is available on all subway, bus, trolley and train schedules.

Bus and Trolley

Fares are paid to the driver when you get on the bus or trolley. You must have exact change.

Train

Tickets may be purchased on the train or at the station. There is an additional charge to purchase tickets on the train when the station office is open.

Special Fares for Seniors

People age 65 or older ride free all day, every day, on busses, trolleys and subways with proper identification. Reduced fares are available on the regional rail lines. Call SEPTA Customer Service for details.

Special Fares for Disabled Riders

People with disabilities may be able to get a ticket at a lower price. Call SEPTA Customer Service for details.

Terminal Location

The main SEPTA terminal serving the Upper Darby community is located at 69th and Market Streets. From this location, you can board the Market-Frankford subway line, the Route 101 and 102 trolleys and the 21, 301, 65, 100, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 116, 120, and 123 bus routes.

Bringing Bicycles

You can bring your bicycle on most SEPTA busses. Route 101 and 102 trolleys do not accommodate bicycles. The Market-Frankford and Broad Street subway lines do not allow bicycles during peak hours, but they are allowed at any time on weekends and holidays.

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 109 *Chester Transportation Center* to 9th Street and Avenue of the States. Walk about 4 minutes.

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 112 *Delaware County Community College, Marple*. Walk approximately 1 minute.

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the 101 *Trolley Orange Street*. Exit at the Veterans Square stop in Media. Walk about 3 minutes. OR Take the 110 Bus *Penn State University, Lima* and exit at Baltimore Pike and Veterans Square. Walk about 5 minutes.

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the 101 *Orange Street* or 102 *Sharon Hill Trolley*. Exit at the Beverly Hills stop in Upper Darby (Garrett Road and Bywood Avenue). Walk approximately 1 minute.

Federal Court House

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the Market-Frankford Line Subway. Exit at 5th Street. Walk about 3 minutes.

Immigration Court

1600 Callowhill Street. Philadelphia, PA 19130

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the MFL Subway. Exit at 15th Street/City Hall. Take the Broad Street Line Subway towards *Fern Rock Transportation Center*. Exit at the Race-Vine stop. Walk approximately 8 minutes.

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the 101 *Orange Street* or 102 *Sharon Hill Trolley*. Exit at the Beverly Hills stop in Upper Darby (Garrett Road and Bywood Avenue). Walk approximately 1 minute.

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 113 *Darby Terminal* to the Darby Transportation Center. Walk approximately 3 minutes.

Upper Darby Welcome Center

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 108 *84th St. Crane St. or UPS, Tinicum* or Bus 113 *Darby Terminal*. Exit at 69th Street Boulevard and Walnut Street in Upper Darby. Walk about 3 minutes.

Upper Darby School District, Administration Building

4611 Bond Ave. Drexel Hill, PA 19026

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 110 *Springfield Mall*. Exit at Township Line Road and Belfield Avenue. Walk approximately 7 minutes to Bond Avenue.

Upper Darby Township Municipal Building

100 Garrett Road. Upper Darby, PA 19082

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 107 *Lawrence Park Shopping Center, Broomall*. Exit at Long Lane and Garrett Road in Upper Darby. Walk approximately 3 minutes.

English Classes at Christ Lutheran Church

7240 Walnut Street. Upper Darby, PA 19082

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the 101 *Orange Street* or 102 *Sharon Hill Trolley*. Exit at the Walnut Street stop (Garrett Road and Walnut Street) in Upper Darby. Walk about 3 minutes.

Health Services

Delaware County Memorial Hospital

501 N. Lansdowne Avenue. Drexel Hill, PA 19026

From 69th Street Terminal: Take the 101 *Orange Street* or 102 *Drexel Hill Junction Trolley*. Exit at the Lansdowne Avenue stop (Garrett Road and Lansdowne Road.) Walk approximately 5 minutes.

Crozer-Chester Medical Center

One Medical Center Boulevard. Upland, PA 19013

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 109 *Chester Transportation Center*. Exit at Chester Transportation Center. Take Bus 117 *Penn State University, Lima*. Exit at Crozer-Chester Medical Center.

Mercy Fitzgerald Hospital

1500 Lansdowne Avenue. Darby, PA 19023

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 113 *Darby Terminal, Darby or Tri-State Mall*. Exit at Lansdowne Avenue and Concord Road. Walk about 1 minute.

100 Garrett Rd. Room 306. Upper Darby, PA 19082

From 69th Street Terminal: Take Bus 107 *Lawrence Park Shopping Center, Broomall*. Exit at Long Lane and Garrett Road. Walk about 3 minutes.
